**LSCU Honors Georgia State Senator John Albers  
as 2021 State Lawmaker of the Year**

**DULUTH, GA** – In December of 2021, the League of Southeastern Credit Unions (LSCU) Board of Directors met to approve strategic plans for 2022 and discuss a number of other business items. Included in items for discussion were 2021 lawmakers of the year. During the nomination and approval process, legislator’s contributions to, and support for, credit unions were discussed at length.

The Georgia Advocacy Policy Committee voted to nominate State Senator John Albers (R-Roswell) as the 2021 State Lawmaker of the Year, which was later approved by the LSCU Board of Directors.

“I am pleased to have been named the 2021 State Lawmaker of the year by LSCU,” said Senator Albers. “The LSCU does an exceptional job providing advocacy, compliance, education, professional networking, communications and other resources to assist its members. I look forward to working with them in the future on bills that have the potential to positively impact the people of Georgia.”

Senator Albers serves as the Chief Deputy Whip and the Vice Chairman of the Finance Committee. In this role, Chairman Albers has been a stalwart leader in the State Senate and consistently looks out for credit unions.

“During the 2021 legislative session, Senator Albers single-handedly saved House Bill 334, the Remote Online Notarization bill, which significantly benefits credit unions by reducing loan turnaround times, increasing operational efficiencies, and further launching member services into the twenty-first century,” noted Patrick La Pine, CEO of LSCU & Affiliates. “Senator Albers serves as a watchdog over tax issues that could negatively impact financial institutions, and we commend him for his dedication to

protecting Georgia consumers and credit unions.”
